Royal International Air Tattoo RAF FAIRFORD

16 TO 18 July 2010
(Public Days 17 & 18)

Again this year at the Royal International Air Tattoo the Air Cadets will have a Radio Station as part of the ACO display. It will again be located with AFCCO, in the Imagineering Marquee. In addition to the HF Radio Station, Cadets will be demonstrating other aspects of Radio Communications Training to RIAT visitors.

Proposed operating times are:

09.00 hours to 17.00 hours local

The Air Cadet call sign in use will be: **MRV 25**

A selection of HF frequencies has been assigned to the ACO for the period of the Tattoo only and must **not** be used at other times. Contact your Wing or Region radio Communications Officer for details.

November 2 may also be used if conditions are difficult.

The Station will not be operating on Air Cadet VHF/UHF frequencies, as these will be used for on site management purposes.

Should it become necessary **MRV 25** will act as HF Network Control Station, or delegate this task to another station. It is planned to have a shadow station on air, using the Callsign **Cadet Charlie Lima** to celebrate the 150 years of the Cadet Forces. This station will assist in passing messages.

MRV 33 will also be on Air from the Management Comms Tent at Fairford.
